All of the Students will stand and silently walk to the stage to perform.

4 rows of 20 on steps in sanctuary stage area
Top stage area - Mrs. Chestnut's class plus a few from Mrs. Royce's class
First step down from the top – Miss Miller's class plus a few from Mrs. Royce's class
Second step down from the top – Mrs. Paul's class plus a few from Mrs. Royce's class
Ground Level - Mrs. Doyle's Class with a few from Mrs. Royce's Class

When all of the students are in position, Mr. Birner will begin the CD. The students will sing the following songs:

We Have Graduation 1:45
A Little Kindness 1:19
Rules For Living 3:21

After applause, the teachers will guide the students to sit back in the pews.

The Individual Classes will Line Up. The students will walk across the stage *right to left* one at a time as directed by a teacher just off stage.

Mr. Auer, Mr. Anspaugh, and Mr. Malatesta will hand the students their "diplomas" and shake each child's hand while one teacher at a time calls out her own student's names.

The students will return to a seat in the front pews guided by a teacher just off the left of the altar.
